MOTION TO REOPEN AND MODIFY DOCKET No. 261 DECISION AND ORDER

Introduction:

T-Mobile (the "Petitioner") respectfully requests that the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") reopen the evidentiary proceeding in Docket No. 261 and modify its Decision and Order ("D&O") dated December 22nd, 2003 as included in Exhibit A. T-Mobile seeks the Council's approval to modify Condition #1 of the D&O by eliminating the condition requiring antennas be attached to the tower via flush mount configurations so as to permit other types of mounting designs, including but not limited to platform mount systems. The approved modification to Condition #1 of the D&O will create no adverse environmental impacts but will in fact further the public interest by reducing barriers to tower sharing and avoiding the unnecessary proliferations of towers.

Background:

On May 30th, 2003, AT&T Wireless PCS, LLC d/b/a AT&T Wireless ("AT&T") applied to the Council for the construction, operation, and maintenance of a wireless telecommunications facility at one of two sites at 85 Quaker Farms Road, Oxford, Connecticut. The property at 85 Quaker Farms Road is approximately 12.5 acres and is owned by William & Elaine Schiavi. By D&O dated December 22, 2003, the Council issued a CPCN to AT&T granting approval to construct at Site B, as defined in the original application.

Subsequent to the issuance of the CPCN, the Council has acknowledged on three separate occasions T-Mobile's notice of intent to modify the tower. See Exhibit B for copies of these acknowledgements.

Request to modify:

On December 4th, 2020, T-Mobile submitted a Notice of Exempt Modification proposing to replace six (6) existing antennas with six (6) new antennas, as well as add three (3) new antennas. This proposal also included mount modifications primarily involving a change from the existing side-arm mount to a new platform mount. On January 6th, 2021, the Council issued an incomplete letter noting that the proposed antenna design and mount modification was not consistent with Condition #1 of the D&O. See Exhibit C for a copy of this letter. Accordingly, T-Mobile now requests that the Council reopen the Docket No. 261 proceeding and modify its D&O to allow



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T-Mobile and other service providers to attach antennas to the existing monopole at the Quaker Farms Road property utilizing platform mounting systems in addition to flush mounts. In support of this request, T-Mobile offers the following additional information:

- 1. The current limitation on antenna mount design restricts wireless carriers', including T-Mobile's, ability to upgrade existing equipment. Flush mount configurations cannot support the additional antennas and supplementary equipment required by wireless carriers in order to provide state-of-the-art reliable wireless service. T-Mobile's existing flush mount configuration is unable to meet the increasing capacity and coverage demands due to the vast changes in T-Mobile's network and technology. For this particular site, T-Mobile can structurally accommodate a platform mount system which will enable T-Mobile to utilize the appropriate antennas/equipment to meet current capacity and coverage demands.
- 2. T-Mobile's requested modification to the D&O Condition No. 1 will not result in any significant nonuniformity or create substantial visual impact. As indicated on the photo simulations included in Exhibit D and the construction drawings for T-Mobile's proposal included as Exhibit E, the proposed platform mount does not constitute a significant change in the aesthetics of the existing facility.

Conclusion:

For the foregoing reasons, T-Mobile respectfully requests that the Council reopen Docket No. 261 and modify Condition No. 1 of the D&O eliminating the requirement that all antennas installed on the monopole utilize flush mount configurations.

Decision and Order

Pursuant to the foregoing Findings of Fact and Opinion, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) finds that the effects associated with the construction, operation, and maintenance of a telecommunications facility including effects on the natural environment; ecological integrity and balance; public health and safety; scenic, historic, and recreational values; forests and parks; air and water purity; and fish and wildlife are not disproportionate either alone or cumulatively with other effects when compared to need, are not in conflict with the policies of the State concerning such effects, and are not sufficient reason to deny the the application and therefore directs that a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need, as provided by General Statutes § 16-50k, be issued to AT&T Wireless PCS d/b/a AT&T Wireless for the construction, maintenance and operation of a wireless telecommunications facility at Site B, located at 85 Quaker Farms Road, Oxford, Connecticut. The Council denies certification of Site A, also located at 85 Quaker Farms Road, Oxford, Connecticut.

The facility shall be constructed, operated, and maintained substantially as specified in the Council's record in this matter, and subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The tower shall be constructed as a monopole, no taller than necessary to provide the proposed telecommunications services, sufficient to accommodate the antennas of AT&T and other entities, both public and private, but such tower shall not exceed a height of 153 feet above ground level, including appurtenances. Antennas installed on the monopole shall be flush mounted.
- 2. The Certificate Holder shall prepare a Development and Management (D&M) Plan for this site in compliance with Sections 16-50j-75 through 16-50j-77 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. The D&M Plan shall be submitted to and approved by the Council prior to the commencement of facility construction and shall include:
 - a) color options for painting the tower, including the color option preferred by the Town of Oxford;
 - b) a final site plan(s) of site development to include specifications for the tower, tower foundation, antennas, equipment building, access road, utility line, and landscaping; and
 - c) construction plans for site clearing, water drainage, and erosion and sedimentation control consistent with the 2002 Connecticut Guidelines for Soil Erosion and Sediment Control, as amended.
- 3. The Certificate Holder shall, prior to the commencement of operation, provide the Council worst-case modeling of electromagnetic radio frequency power density of all proposed entities' antennas at the closest point of uncontrolled access to the tower base, consistent with Federal Communications Commission, Office of Engineering and Technology, Bulletin No. 65, August 1997. The Certificate Holder shall ensure a recalculated report of electromagnetic radio frequency power density is submitted to the Council if and when circumstances in operation cause a change in power density above the levels calculated and provided pursuant to this Decision and Order.

- 4. Upon the establishment of any new State or federal radio frequency standards applicable to frequencies of this facility, the facility granted herein shall be brought into compliance with such standards.
- 5. The Certificate Holder shall permit public or private entities to share space on the proposed tower for fair consideration, or shall provide any requesting entity with specific legal, technical, environmental, or economic reasons precluding such tower sharing. The Certificate Holder shall provide space on the tower for no compensation for any municipal antennas, provided such antennas are compatible with the structural integrity of the tower.
- 6. If the facility does not initially provide wireless services within one year of completion of construction or ceases to provide wireless services for a period of one year, this Decision and Order shall be void, and the Certificate Holder shall dismantle the tower and remove all associated equipment or reapply for any continued or new use to the Council before any such use is made.
- 7. Any antenna that becomes obsolete and ceases to function shall be removed within 60 days after such antennas become obsolete and cease to function.
- 8. Unless otherwise approved by the Council, this Decision and Order shall be void if the facility authorized herein is not operational within one year of the effective date of this Decision and Order or within one year after all appeals to this Decision and Order have been resolved.

Pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50p, we hereby direct that a copy of the Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order be served on each person listed below, and notice of issuance shall be published in the Waterbury Republican-American.

By this Decision and Order, the Council disposes of the legal rights, duties, and privileges of each party named or admitted to the proceeding in accordance with Section 16-50j-17 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

At a public meeting held on January 18, 2007, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) acknowledged your notice to modify this existing telecommunications facility, pursuant to Section 16-50j-73 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

The proposed modifications are to be implemented as specified here and in your notice dated December 20, 2006, including the placement of all necessary equipment and shelters within the tower compound. The modifications are in compliance with the exception criteria in Section 16-50j-72 (b) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies as changes to an existing facility site that would not increase tower height, extend the boundaries of the tower site, increase noise levels at the tower site boundary by six decibels, and increase the total radio frequencies electromagnetic radiation power density measured at the tower site boundary to or above the standard adopted by the State Department of Environmental Protection pursuant to General Statutes § 22a-162. This facility has also been carefully modeled to ensure that radio frequency emissions are conservatively below State and federal standards applicable to the frequencies now used on this tower.

Any additional change to this facility will require explicit notice to this agency pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-73. Such notice shall include all relevant information regarding the proposed change with cumulative worst-case modeling of radio frequency exposure at the closest point of uncontrolled access to the tower base, consistent with Federal Communications Commission, Office of Engineering and Technology, Bulletin 65. Any deviation from this format may result in the Council implementing enforcement proceedings pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50u including, without limitation, imposition of expenses resulting from such failure and of civil penalties in an amount not less than one thousand dollars per day for each day of construction or operation in material violation.

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) hereby acknowledges your notice to modify this existing telecommunications facility, pursuant to Section 16-50j-73 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies with the following conditions:

- Prior to any proposed tower load changes, T-Mobile shall remove the empty antenna mounts at the 99-foot and 109-foot levels of the tower in accordance with the structural analysis report prepared by Crown Castle, dated February 10, 2015 and stamped by Andrew Fandozzi;
- Within 45 days following completion of the equipment installation, T-Mobile shall provide documentation that its installation complied with the recommendations included in the Structural Analysis Report;
- Any deviation from the proposed modification as specified in this notice and supporting materials with the Council shall render this acknowledgement invalid;
- Any material changes to this modification as proposed shall require the filing of a new notice with the Council;
- Within 45 days after completion of construction, the Council shall be notified in writing that construction has been completed;
- Any nonfunctioning antenna and associated antenna mounting equipment on this facility owned and
 operated by T-Mobile shall be removed within 60 days of the date the antenna ceased to function;
- The validity of this action shall expire one year from the date of this letter; and
- The applicant may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one year deadline provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 60 days prior to the expiration.

The proposed modifications including the placement of all necessary equipment and shelters within the tower compound are to be implemented as specified here and in your notice dated February 19, 2015. The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) received a notice of intent to modify the above-referenced facility on December 4, 2020.

According to Section 16-50j-71 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, "...any modification, as defined in Section 16-50j-2a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, to an existing tower site, except as specified in Sections 16-50j-72 and 16-50j-88 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, may have a substantial adverse environmental effect."

Staff has reviewed this exempt modification request for completeness and has identified a deficiency in the proposed antenna mount that is not compliant with the Council's Decision and Order for Docket No. 261 dated December 22, 2003. Condition No. 1 of the above referenced Decision and Order states "Antennas installed on the monopole shall be flush mounted."

The proposed exempt modification request indicates that T-Mobile's proposed mount is not in compliance with the Council's condition of approval for this facility.

Therefore, the exempt modification request is incomplete at this time. The Council recommends that Crown Castle provide a revised request that is in compliance with the Council's Decision and Order in Docket No. 261 or submit a motion to reopen Docket No. 261 to modify the condition requiring flush mounted antennas on the subject tower, on or before February 8, 2021. If additional time is needed to gather the requested information, please submit a written request for an extension of time prior to February 8, 2021. Please provide an electronic version of the requested information for the incomplete exempt modification to be rendered complete and processed. Please include the Council's exempt modification identification number referenced above with the submittal.

This notice of incompletion shall have the effect of tolling the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) 60-day timeframe in accordance with Paragraph 217 of the FCC Wireless Infrastructure Report and Order issued on October 21, 2014 (FCC 14-153).
