

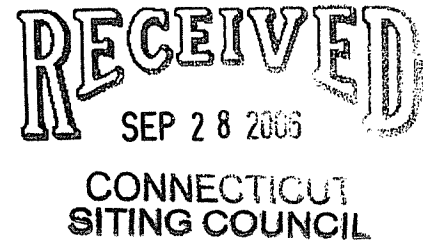

NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-501(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 16-501-1(e) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies of an Application to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council ("Siting Council") on August 25, 2006 or thereafter by Optasite, Inc. and Omnipoint Communications, Inc., a subsidiary of T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-Mobile") (collectively the "Applicants"). The Applicants will request a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need from the Siting Council for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility in Waterbury, Connecticut. The Applicants are proposing to construct a new monopole tower on an approximately 104 acre property at 940 Meriden Road in Waterbury and owned by the Pine Grove Cemetery Association (the "Property"). The Applicants propose to construct a new 120' self-supporting monopole tower and antennas in the north central portion of the Property. The location, height and other features of the proposed facility are subject to review and potential change under provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50g et. seq.

The proposed facility would provide personal wireless communication service in portions of Waterbury and surrounding areas, which do not have adequate service. The Application will explain the need, purpose and benefits of the facility and will also describe the environmental impacts of the proposed facility.

A balloon representative of the proposed height will be flown on the day of the Siting Council public hearing on the Application, which will take place in the City of Waterbury. The balloon will be flown from approximately 2 p.m. to 5 p.m. Notice of the public hearing date will be provided by the Siting Council.
