 amount not to exceed \$3,900,000 and to apply grants and such other funds  
 available therefor in an amount estimated to be \$700,000; and (c) to take all  
 actions relating to the foregoing as may be necessary or appropriate.

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-501(b) of  
 the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 16-501-  
 1(e) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies of  
 an Application to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting  
 Council ("Siting Council") on January 18, 2007 or there-  
 after by Optasite Towers LLC and Omnipoint Communi-  
 cations, Inc., a subsidiary of T-Mobile USA, Inc. ("T-  
 Mobile") (collectively the "Applicants"). The Applicants  
 will request a certificate of environmental compatibility  
 and public need from the Siting Council for the con-  
 struction, maintenance and operation of a telecommuni-  
 cations facility in Manchester, Connecticut. The Appli-  
 cants are proposing to construct a new monopole tower  
 at 1027 Middle Turnpike East, Manchester, Connecticut  
 and is owned by Urban Realty Company (the "Property").  
 The Applicants propose to construct a new 130' self-  
 supporting stealth monopole tower, antennas, associ-  
 ated equipment and other site improvements integral to  
 a wireless communications facility. The location, height  
 and other features of the proposed facility are subject to  
 review and potential change under provisions of the  
 Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50g et. seq.

The proposed facility would provide personal wireless  
 communication service in the Towns of Manchester and  
 Bolton along State Highway 85, Middle Turnpike and in  
 adjacent areas, which do not have adequate service.  
 The Application will explain the need, purpose and  
 benefits of the facility and will also describe the envi-  
 ronmental impacts of the proposed facility.  
 A balloon representative of the proposed height will be  
 flown on the day of the Siting Council public hearing on  
 the Application, which will take place in the Town of  
 Manchester. The balloon will be flown from approxi-  
 mately 12 p.m. to 5 p.m. Notice of the public hearing  
 date will be provided by the Siting Council.
