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## NOTICE

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-501(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 16-501-1(e) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies of an Application to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council ("Siting Council") on or after June 7, 2007 by Optasite Towers LLC and Omnipoint Communications, Inc., a subsidiary of T-Mobile USA, Inc. d/b/a T-Mobile ("T-Mobile") (collectively the "Applicants"). The Applicants will request a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need from the Siting Council for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility in Ansonia, Connecticut. The Applicants are proposing to construct a new monopole tower at 1 Deerfield Lane, Ansonia, Connecticut and is owned by Macabee Properties, LLC (the "Property"). The Applicants propose to construct a new 180 foot, self-supporting stealth monopole, antennas, associated equipment and other site improvements integral to a wireless communications facility. The location, height and other features of the proposed facility are subject to review and potential change under provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50g *et seq.*

The proposed Facility will provide service in the Towns of Ansonia and Woodbridge along Route 313, Peck Hill Road and in adjacent areas, which do not have adequate service. The Application will explain the need, purpose and benefits of the facility and will also describe the environmental impacts of the proposed facility.

A balloon representative of the proposed height will be flown on the day of the Siting Council public hearing on the Application, which will take place in the Town of Ansonia. The balloon will be flown from approximately 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Notice of the public hearing will be provided by the Siting Council.
