### **Pre-Construction Activities**

Pre-construction activities completed included the continued maintenance of E&S controls.

### **Construction Activities**

Construction activities conducted included the removal of capacitor banks and associated enclosures.

There were no deviations associated with work completed in Q2 2026.

### **Construction Stormwater General Permit: Update**

The Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (CTDEEP) issued the *General Permit for the Discharge of Stormwater from Construction Activities* on January 1, 2026. Interim permit coverage for permittees under the previous General Permit was granted by CTDEEP, provided a renewal application was submitted by April 1, 2026.

As required, the Project applied for permit renewal prior to April 1, 2026, and was granted full coverage under the *General Permit for the Discharge of Stormwater from Construction Activities* on May 26, 2026.
