**D&M Plan Change - Request for Temporary Extended Work Hours.**

Dear Richard Pinto:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of correspondence dated April 21, 2025 regarding a revision to the Development and Management (D&M) Plan for the above-referenced facility that was approved by the Council on August 28, 2020.

Pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) §16-50j-62 (b), Council staff hereby approves a temporary change to the D&M Plan to allow for construction activities to occur on a 24/7 basis from April 21, 2025 through May 5, 2025. The extended work hours are necessary to meet scheduled outages.

This approval applies only to the request for temporary extended work hours, dated April 21, 2025.

Please be advised that deviations from the standards established by the Council's Decision and Order and D&M Plan approvals are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to RCSA § 16-50j-62.

Pursuant to the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-62(b)(2) and *Section 7.2-Construction Work Hours* of the Project's Development & Management (D&M) Plan (approved August 27, 2020), The United Illuminating Company ("UI") is hereby notifying the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") for construction activities that will be performed on a 24 hour, 7 days a week basis.

Due to necessary line outages and an effort to complete the Project in an efficient manner, work shall be conducted on a 24/7 basis from today, April 21, 2025, and continue to May 5, 2025. However, construction activities requiring the extended work hours may be completed prior to May 5, 2025. UI shall notify the Council when the work requiring the 24/7 schedule has been completed.

Erosion and sedimentation controls, noise, and lighting mitigation conditions will be implemented during construction activities, as needed and in compliance with the Project's Stormwater Pollution Control Plan (SWPCP) and D&M Plan.
