We are writing on behalf of our client New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T") in response to the post hearing brief filed by counsel for the intervenors on Friday afternoon. Having reviewed same, we wish to note for the record our disagreement with various factual and legal assertions, including those arguments made with respect to the nature of this petition for a declaratory ruling, Section 22a-19 of the Connecticut General Statutes and the intervenors' characterizations of the law governing the Council's review.
