Re: Montville Power LLC, Petition No. 907

Dear Mr. Phelps:

I write on behalf of NRG Energy, Inc. ("NRG") and Montville Power LLC ("Montville Power") to provide the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council") with a report on Montville Power's evaluation of the feasibility of relocating the fuel receiving area for the proposed Montville Biomass project.

As you may recall, as part of an agreement with the Town of Montville (the "Town"), as more fully described in a joint letter from Montville Power and the Town, dated October 16, 2009 (the Joint Letter"), Montville Power agreed to evaluate the feasibility of relocating the fuel receiving area to address comments from neighbors and the Town. Specifically, in Item 3 of the Joint Letter, Montville Power made the following commitment:

Montville Power will pursue the suggestion by neighbors to move the current planned location of the fuel receiving area, to provide a greater distance between the facility and the closest neighbors' house. Relocating this portion of the Project will go a long way in addressing noise and property value concerns. We recognize that Montville Power must first complete an engineering study of the revised location to determine whether this option is doable from engineering and economic perspectives.

Montville Power has completed its evaluation and has determined that it is feasible to relocate the fuel receiving area to address the expressed concerns. Specifically, as shown on the attached Facility Diagram, the fuel handling activities can be moved to a new location, which is approximately 1,000 feet from Lathrop Road. The revised design will allow all of the fuel handling equipment to be located east of the railroad tracks that bisect the site and very close to the existing generation buildings and fuel storage tanks. The redesigned layout will reduce the noise associated with fuel deliveries and will address concerns regarding the aesthetics of the original design.

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Montville Power has shared the revised layout with the Mayor of Montville. Montville Power anticipates that the Mayor will communicate acceptance of the redesign to the Council shortly.

Based on the foregoing, Montville Power requests that the Council incorporate the revised layout of the fuel handling facilities as part of any approval of Petition No. 907.


