SUPPLEMENTAL SUBMISSION

North Atlantic Towers, LLC and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T") respectfully submit this supplemental information:

Average Height of the Tree Canopy

The average height of the tree canopy in the wooded area in the vicinity of the proposed replacement monopole is approximately 50'-60'.

Updated Visual Materials

Update visual materials are provided in Attachment 1. The captions provided with the photosimulations were updated to more accurately reflect the photosimulation. In addition, a photo location map is provided.

Number of Residences within 1,000'

Twenty-six (26) residences are located within 1,000' of the existing lattice tower and proposed replacement monopole.

Distance to the Nearest Residential Structure

The closest residential structure is located approximately 273' from the proposed replacement monopole with an address of 41 Tower Lane. Enclosed in Attachment 2 is a drawing depicting the closest residence.

Existing Towers and Structures within Four (4) Miles

Enclosed in Attachment 3 is a list and map of existing wireless facilities located within four (4) miles of the proposed replacement monopole.

Tower and Foundation Design

As shown in the drawings submitted in Attachment 1 of Petition No. 973, the 120' proposed replacement monopole facility is designed to accommodate three additional carriers' facilities. The replacement monopole and foundation can be designed for future height extensions.


### RF Plots

The coverage plot titled "Existing & Proposed Coverage" provided in Attachment 7 of Petition No. 973, which demonstrates the need for the proposed replacement monopole, depicts proposed coverage utilizing the 850 MHz band.
