This letter is respectfully submitted on behalf of North Atlantic Towers, LLC and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T") in connection with the above referenced declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required to replace an abandoned tower with a new tower facility at 880 Andrew Mountain Road in Naugatuck.

By letter dated June 21, 2012, the Siting Council granted a one-year extension of time for the completion of the Facility to May 4, 2013. In accordance with Condition number 10 of the Council's April 28, 2011 Decision and Order, we respectfully request a six month extension of time to November 4, 2013 for the Facility to be fully operational. The construction of the replacement Facility is complete and AT&T requires additional time to install its antennas and related equipment such that the Facility is fully operational.
