Dear Ms. Roberts:

This letter is respectfully submitted on behalf of North Atlantic Towers, LLC and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (“AT&T”) in connection with the above referenced declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required to replace an abandoned tower with a new tower facility at 880 Andrew Mountain Road in Naugatuck.

Condition number 9 of the Council’s Decision and Order dated April 28, 2011 requires the approved facility to be constructed and providing wireless services within eighteen months from the date of the mailing of the Council’s Findings of Fact, Opinion, Decision and Order. That date is estimated as November 4, 2012.

In accordance with Condition number 10 of the Council’s Decision and Order, we respectfully request a six month extension of time from November 4, 2012 to May 4, 2013. The utility easement process was longer than anticipated and as such, North Atlantic Towers requires additional time to construct the replacement tower facility.
