**PETITION NO. 980** - BNE Energy, Inc. petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 3.2 MW Wind Renewable Generating facility located at 178 New Haven Road, Prospect, Connecticut.

During the evidentiary hearing for the above-referenced matter on March 15, 2011, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) ruled on the following motions and objections:

1. Connecticut Light & Power (CL&P) Motion for Protective Order dated March 8,

CL&P's Motion for Protective Order was granted.

2. FairwindCT, Inc. (Fairwind) Objection and Motion to Modify BNE Protective Order issued on February 24, 2011, dated March 7, 2011.

Fairwind's Objection and Motion to Modify BNE Protective Order issued on February 24, 2011 were denied.

BNE Objection to Save Prospect Corp. (SPC) Pre-Filed Exhibits and Requests for 3. Administrative Notice dated March 14, 2011.

BNE's Objection to SPC Pre-Filed Exhibits and Requests for Administrative Notice was denied.

4. BNE Motions to Strike Pre-Filed Testimony of SPC witnesses, John Ford, John Hurley, Kurt Tramposch, Timothy Reilly, David Pressman and Michael McCann dated March 14, 2011.

BNE's Motions to Strike the Pre-Filed Testimony of SPC witnesses were denied.

5. BNE Objection to Subpoenas dated March 11, 2011 issued by SPC to the Connecticut Clean Energy Fund and Connecticut Innovations dated March 14, 2011.

BNE's Objection to Subpoenas issued by SPC was denied.

The next evidentiary hearing scheduled for March 31, 2011 shall commence with cross examination of the petitioner by the Town of Prospect. Thereafter, the hearing will continue with the cross examination of the remaining parties and intervenors (Satkunas/LaMontagne, Connecticut Water and CL&P) by the Council, petitioner and other parties and intervenors. Finally, the hearing will conclude with further cross examination of the petitioner by the Council and parties and intervenors. Parties and intervenors have two hours collectively remaining for cross examination of the petitioner. Satkunas/LaMontagne, Connecticut Water and CL&P shall have their first opportunity to cross examine the petitioner and any remaining time shall be allotted to SPC/Fairwind/Bibler.
