RE: **PETITION NO. 980** - BNE Energy, Inc. petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 3.2 MW Wind Renewable Generating facility located at 178 New Haven Road, Prospect, Connecticut.

PETITION NO. 983 - BNE Energy, Inc. petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 4.8 MW Wind Renewable Generating facility located on Flagg Hill Road, Colebrook, Connecticut.

PETITION NO. 984 - BNE Energy, Inc. petition for a declaratory ruling that no Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need is required for the construction, maintenance, and operation of a 4.8 MW Wind Renewable Generating facility located on Winsted-Norfolk Road (Route 44), Colebrook, Connecticut.

In reference to the above-mentioned petitions, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) has considered the following matters:

1. FairwindCT, Inc.'s (Fairwind) Request to Consolidate the Evidentiary Hearings for Petitions 980, 983 and 984 dated January 31, 2011.

At a meeting of the Council held on February 8, 2011, the Council voted to deny Fairwind's Request to Consolidate the Evidentiary Hearings for Petitions 980, 983 and 984 dated January 31, 2011 on the basis that each petition has a different deadline for decision, different parties and intervenors, different site locations and different residents with site-specific concerns.

2. Grouping of Parties with the Same Interests.

Also at the Council meeting held on February 8, 2011, the Council voted in accordance with its statutory authority under Conn. Gen. Stat. §16-50n(c) to group the following parties and intervenors in each proceeding with the same interests:



Petition 980:

The Council voted to group Save Prospect Corp. and Fairwind on the basis that both parties have the same interests in that each filed for status as a non-profit corporation formed to promote conservation or natural beauty, to protect the environment, personal health and biological values, to preserve historical sites, to promote consumer interests and to promote the orderly development of the areas in which the facilities are to be located under Conn. Gen. Stat. §16-50n(a)(3).

Petition 983:

The Council voted to group Fairwind and Stella and Michael Somers (the Somers) on the basis that both parties have the same interests in that each filed for party status to protect historic and cultural resources, particularly Rock Hall Luxe Lodging and to protect the use and enjoyment and natural beauty of property in proximity to the proposed project, as well as to protect area property values, tourism and commercial viability. The Council also exercised its discretion to group Fairwind and the Somers on the basis that Ms. Stella Somers is listed as the Secretary and a Director of Fairwind in the corporation documents filed with the Secretary of the State. Both parties are also represented by the same counsel.

Petition 984:

The Council voted to group Fairwind, the Somers and Susan Wagner on the basis that all three parties have the same interests in that each filed for party status to protect the use and enjoyment and natural beauty of property in proximity to the proposed project, as well as to protect area property values, tourism and commercial viability. The Council also exercised its discretion to group Fairwind, the Somers and Susan Wagner on the basis that Ms. Stella Somers is listed as the Secretary and a Director of Fairwind and Ms. Susan Wagner is listed as the Treasurer of Fairwind in the corporation documents filed with the Secretary of the State. All of the parties are also represented by the same counsel.

The grouped parties shall conduct cross examination of the petitioner and other parties and intervenors, and present their direct cases as a joint panel during the evidentiary proceedings. This does not preclude any grouped party from submitting individual pre-filed testimony, exhibits or interrogatories, nor does it preclude any grouped party from conducting individual cross examination of the petitioner and other participants. Moreover, it does not preclude any other proceeding participants from conducting individual cross examination of grouped parties.

3. Petition 980 Evidentiary Hearing Continuation Dates.

Given the number of participants in this proceeding, continuation of the evidentiary hearings shall be necessary. The Council announces the following dates for continuation of the evidentiary hearings:
