In response to Question 15 of the Connecticut Siting Council's first set of interrogatories, and on behalf of BNE Energy, Vanasse Hangen Brustlin, Inc. (VHB) is submitting the attached photosimulations from Lee Road, Coachlight Circle, Barbara Avenue and George Street. A photo log map depicting the locations of the photographs is also included.

Consistent with the Visual Resource Evaluation Report that was filed with BNE's Petition, views from these locations are predicted to be seasonal (during "leaf-off" conditions) at best, and generally limited to upper reaches of the turbine hub or portions of the blades through the trees.

Because the turbines and blades will be obscured from most of these views by the dense intervening tree mast/branching during those months of the year when leaves are off the trees (as can be seen in these photos), VHB placed a silhouette (in red outline) of the turbines within the photos, representing each turbine's location, ground elevation and dimensions relative to the view point.

With the exception of the view from Barbara Avenue (where the top of Turbine One is evident above the tree line), the photos illustrate that most views from these areas will not have direct lines of sight towards the turbines. The majority of views from these streets appear to be non-visible.
