According to Merriam-Webster Dictionary, *proprietary* is "something that is used, produced, or marketed under exclusive legal right of the inventor or maker; *specifically*: a drug (as a patent medicine) that is protected by secrecy, patent, or copyright against free competition as to name, product, composition, or process of manufacture."
