Dear Mr. van Wilgen:

At a public meeting held on August 31, 1999, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) acknowledged your intent to install this temporary cellular telecommunications facility in Avon, Connecticut, pursuant to Section 16-50j-73 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

The proposed modifications are to be implemented as specified here and in your request dated August 6, 1999. The temporary cellular facility is in compliance with the exception criteria in Section 16-50j-72 (d) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies as a temporary mobile site that provides essential telephone service to an event of statewide significance supporting economic development. This facility has been carefully modeled to ensure that radio frequency emissions are conservatively below State and federal standards applicable to the frequency proposed to be used on this equipment. Any change to this facility will require explicit notice to this agency pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-73. Such notice shall include all relevant information regarding the proposed change with cumulative worst-case modeling of radio frequency exposure at the closest point of uncontrolled access to the tower base, consistent with Federal Communications Commission, Office of Engineering and Technology, Bulletin No. 65. Any deviation from this format may result in the Council implementing enforcement proceedings pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50u including, without limitation, imposition of expenses resulting from such failure and of civil penalties in an amount not less than one thousand dollars per day for each day of construction or operation in material violation.



Cell Site

Dear Chairman Gelston:

Springwich Cellular Limited Partnership ("SCLP") has been chosen to be host of the SNET/SBC's Southwest User Maintenance Group (SMUG) conference which is scheduled to be held on September 12, 1999 through September 14, 1999. The chosen site for the conference this year is the Avon Old Farms Hotel in the Town of Avon, CT. During this conference, additional temporary cellular support will be required at this location. SCLP is requesting permission to establish this temporary site on September 3, 1999 for testing purposes prior to the conference to ensure service area coverage levels will be sufficient at this location. To address this situation, SCLP requests the authority to temporarily place a portable "Cell On Wheels" (COW) vehicle behind the hotel at the conference site. SCLP's COW will be powered by a portable generator and utilize an attached hydraulic mast which supports the antenna array. Please accept this letter as notice of intent, pursuant to R.C.S.A. Section 16-50j-73, of construction which constitutes an exempt modification pursuant to R.C.S.A., Section 16-50j-72(d). In further compliance with R.C.S.A. Section 16-50j-73, a copy of this letter is being sent to the Town Manager of Avon.

The planned temporary cell site meets the criteria set forth in R.C.S.A. Section 16-50j72(d) for temporary cellular service for events of statewide significance. This site is necessary to provide temporary additional system capacity to accommodate increased communication needs at this conference and the surrounding service areas.

The COW or temporary cell site consists of radio equipment installed on or within a vehicle (COW) with the associated temporary antenna mast. This temporary cellular site (COW) is 17ft. 3 inches in length, 6 ft. 6 inches in width and 11 ft. 10 inches in height. The height of the hydraulic antenna mast is 62 feet above ground level.

Power Density Calculations

The operation of these additional antennas will not increase the total radio frequency electromagnetic radiation power density to a level at or above the ANSI standard. A "worst-case" calculation, from a point of interest from the centerline of the antenna mounted on the mast to ground level indicates that SCLP's cellular operations result in a Power Density Calculation of 0.0749, which is 12.76% of the maximum permissible emissions allowed. (See chart listings) This calculation was arrived at using an antenna height of 62 ft. and an operating power of 40 watts per channel. (See Chart Below)
