Dear Attorney Fisher:

At a public meeting held on January 28, 2003, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) acknowledged your notice to modify these existing telecommunications facilities, pursuant to Section 16-50j-73 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

The proposed modifications are to be implemented as specified here and in your notice dated January 10, 2003. The modifications are in compliance with the exception criteria in Section 16-50j-72 (b) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies as changes to an existing facility sites that would not increase tower heights, extend the boundaries of the tower site, increase noise levels at the tower site boundaries by six decibels, and increase the total radio frequencies electromagnetic radiation power density measured at the tower site boundaries to or above the standard adopted by the State Department of Environmental Protection pursuant to General Statutes § 22a-162. These facilities have also been carefully modeled to ensure that radio frequency emissions are conservatively below State and federal standards applicable to the frequencies now used on these towers.

This decision is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Council. Any additional change to these facilities will require explicit notice to this agency pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-73. Such notice shall include all relevant information regarding the proposed change with cumulative worst-case modeling of radio frequency exposure at the closest point of uncontrolled access to the tower base, consistent with Federal Communications Commission, Office of Engineering and Technology, Bulletin 65. Any deviation from this format may result in the Council implementing enforcement proceedings pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50u including, without limitation, imposition of expenses resulting from such failure and of civil penalties in an amount not less than one thousand dollars per day for each day of construction or operation in material violation.

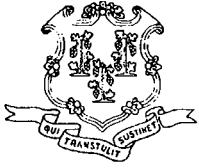

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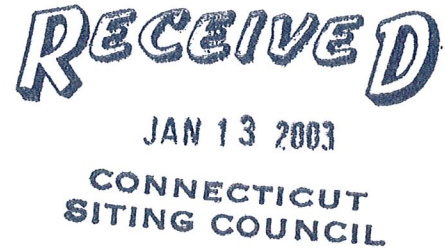

Hon. Mortimer Gelston, Chairman and Members of the Siting Council:

On March 21, 2002 the Council acknowledged AT&T's Notice of Exempt Modification for its Facility on an existing CL&P electric transmission tower (EM-AT&T-009-051-020227) pursuant to Section 16-50g. et seq. of the General Statutes of Connecticut. AT&T's existing facility consists of three panel antennas on an extension mast on an existing CL&P transmission line structure with associated equipment cabinets in a fenced compound at the base of the structure located at 7 Stony Hill Road in Bethel, Connecticut.

At this time, AT&T is notifying the Connecticut Siting Council of its intent to modify the existing facility pursuant to Section 16-50j-72 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. AT&T will be replacing existing antennas and installing three additional equipment cabinets (approximately 60"H x 28"D) on AT&T's existing concrete pad at the facility. There will be no other infrastructure changes to AT&T's facility.

The proposed addition of equipment to AT&T Wireless' facility does not constitute a "modification" of an existing facility as defined in Connecticut General Statutes Section 16-

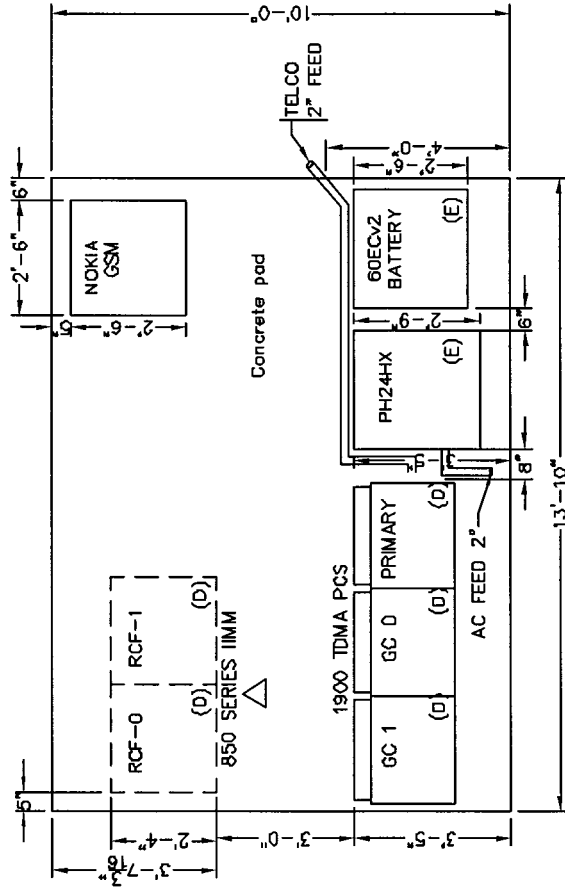

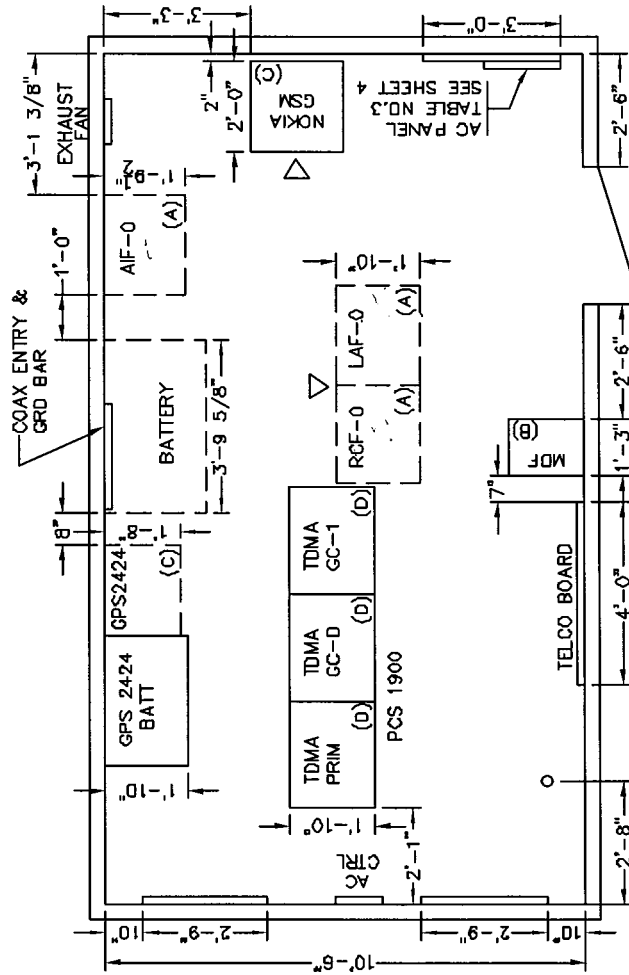

On March 7, 2002 the Council acknowledged AT&T's Notice of Exempt Modification for its Facility on an existing CL&P electric transmission facility (EM-AT&T-035-057-103-130-020307) pursuant to Section 16-50g. et seq. of the General Statutes of Connecticut. AT&T's existing facility consists of six panel antennas on a 14" diameter extension mast on existing CL&P transmission line structure number 1255 with an associated equipment shelter at the base of the structure located off Sound Beach Avenue in Greenwich, Connecticut.

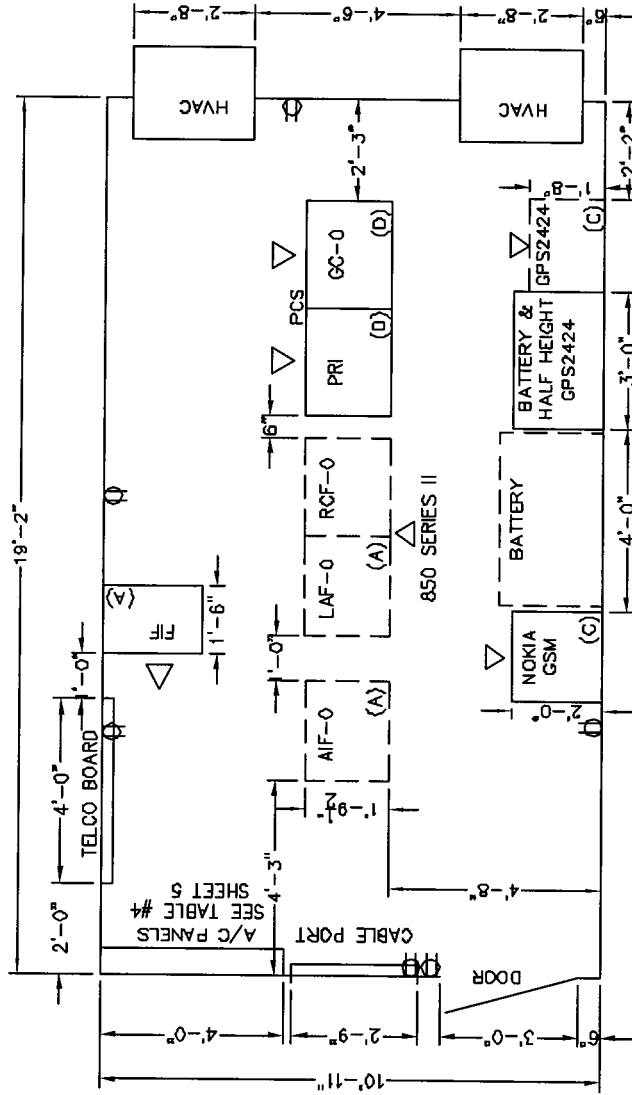
