Request for Extension

Dear Ms. Bachman:

The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) received acknowledgement from the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) on May 11, 2020, that Eversource’s proposed modifications to an existing telecommunications facility located at 790 Willis Street in Bristol would comply with the exempt modification criteria in Section 16-50j-57 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. In its acknowledgement, the Council included conditions regarding the modification work, including, specifically the following:


- The petitioner may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one-year deadline, provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 60 days prior to the expiration.

Due to the construction and testing schedule being delayed, Eversource previously requested an extension of the deadline to November 11, 2021. However, the approved equipment has not yet been fully tested and Eversource hereby requests that the deadline to complete these activities be extended to May 11, 2022.
