Terracon Consultants, Inc. (Terracon) is pleased to submit this Summary of Special Inspections for the above-referenced tower project. We provided Special Inspections services related to antenna mount upgrades. A Terracon Field Report has been issued under separate cover.

The site is located at 751 Higgins Road in Cheshire, Connecticut and has been developed with an approximately 254-foot high self-supporting lattice telecommunications tower and associated equipment cabinets and identified on the project drawings as Site CT03XC044. The project consists of replacing existing antennas and their structural mounts.

On October 20, 2014, a Terracon Steel Inspector/International Code Council Bolting Special Inspector visited the site to review previously installed antenna mounts and fastening assemblies for general conformance to the project requirements. Our field review was completed without issue. Based on this review the project was observed to be completed in general conformance to the project requirements.
