Our firm represents the Town of Cheshire in various matters, including proceedings involving the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council"). The Town is in receipt of your letter, dated March 1, 2017, directed to Robert Oris, Jr. in his capacity as Chairman of the Cheshire Town Council, concerning the above referenced submission by T-Mobile claiming that its modifications to the telecommunications facility located at 1119 Summit Road qualify as an exempt modification under the Council's regulations. Based on the records of the Town, the chief elected official did not receive or was not provided with written notification from T-Mobile of its proposed modifications as required under R.C.S.A. § 16-50j-73. But for your March 1, 2017, letter, the Town would not have been aware of the proposed modifications or T-Mobile's contention that such modifications constituted an exempt modification.

In order to allow the Town sufficient time to evaluate T-Mobile's submission, the Town respectfully requests that the Council allow the Town to provide its written comments by April 14, 2017.
