EM-VER-033-030509 - Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless notice of intent to install a temporary cellular telephone facility for use at the Canon Greater Hartford Open (GHO) on River Highlands property located off Glenwood Road, Cromwell, Connecticut.

Dear Attorney Baldwin:

At a public meeting held on May 20, 2003, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) acknowledged your notice to construct a temporary telecommunications facility, pursuant to Section 16-50j-73 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

The proposed facility is to be developed as specified here and in your notices dated May 9, 2002. The facility is in compliance with the exception criteria in Section 16-50j-72 (d) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies for temporary cellular service for events of statewide significance. This temporary facility has also been carefully modeled to ensure that radio frequency emissions are conservatively below State and federal standards applicable to the frequencies now used on this tower.

This decision is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Council. Any additional change to this temporary facility will require explicit notice to this agency pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-73. Such notice shall include all relevant information regarding the proposed change with cumulative worst-case modeling of radio frequency exposure at the closest point of uncontrolled access to the tower base, consistent with Federal Communications Commission, Office of Engineering and Technology, Bulletin 65. Any deviation from this format may result in the Council implementing enforcement proceedings pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50u including, without limitation, imposition of expenses resulting from such failure and of civil penalties in an amount not less than one thousand dollars per day for each day of construction or operation in material violation.

Greater Hartford Open – Temporary Telecommunications Facility Cromwell, Connecticut

Dear Mr. Phelps:

Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Cellco") plans to install a temporary cellular telecommunications facility for use during the Greater Hartford Open ("GHO") on the grounds of the River Highlands Golf Club in Cromwell, Connecticut. Please accept this letter as notification pursuant to R.C.S.A. Section 16-50j-73, for construction that constitutes an exempt modification pursuant to R.C.S.A. Section 16-50j-72(d)(2). In accordance with R.C.S.A. Section 16-50j-73, a copy of this letter is being sent to the Cromwell First Selectman, Stanley A. Terry, Jr.

The proposed temporary telecommunications facility will consist of a vehicle-mounted radio equipment shelter and antenna mast, commonly referred to as a "cell on wheels" or "COW" (see attachment). The Verizon Wireless COW will have dimensions of approximately 31 feet in length, by 8 feet wide, by 13 feet high. The overall height of the antenna mast will be approximately 60 feet above ground level. The centerline of antennas attached to the mast will be approximately 57 feet above ground level.

The proposed temporary telecommunications facility satisfies the criteria set forth in R.C.S.A. Section 16-50j-72(d)(2) as a facility that will provide temporary cellular telephone service for an event of State-wide significance. This facility will provide temporary additional system capacity to accommodate increased communications needs associated with the GHO. The temporary facility will be placed in a designated area on

the River Highlands property, located off Glenwood Road in Cromwell. The COW will begin service on or about July 9, 2003, to be available during tournament setup and will be removed approximately one week after conclusion of the event.

The operation of the antennas on the COW will not result in a total radio frequency (RF) power density level at or above the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) adopted safety standard. The "worst-case" calculation for a point on the ground, adjacent to the COW, using parameters of 6 channels and 200 watts per channel, indicates that a Cellco temporary facility will result in power density levels of approximately 0.1328 mW/cm² or 23.4% of the FCC standard.

For the foregoing reasons, Cellco respectfully submits that the proposed temporary installation for the GHO constitutes an exempt modification under R.C.S.A. Section 16-50j-72(d)(2).




