Dear Attorney Bachman:

The Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") acknowledged the above referenced T-Mobile Northeast LLC ("T-Mobile") Exempt Modification on October 6, 2025. T-Mobile hereby notifies the Council that construction of the acknowledged installation was complete as of February 6, 2026. T-Mobile is now requesting the close out of the approval and hereby acknowledges the following conditions were met:

1. Approval of any changes be delegated to Council staff;
2. Antennas and equipment shall be installed in accordance with the Mount Analysis prepared by Sinnott Gering and Schmitt Towers, Inc. dated May 19, 2025 and stamped and signed by Nicholas J. Schmitt;
3. Within 45 days following completion of equipment installation, T-Mobile shall provide documentation certified by a Professional Engineer that its installation complied with the recommendations of the Mount Analysis;
4. RF access restriction and caution signage shall be installed at the site in compliance with FCC guidance;
5. Deployment of any 5G services must comply with FCC and FAA guidance relative to air navigation, as applicable;
6. Any deviation from the proposed modification as specified in this notice and supporting materials submitted to the Council shall render this acknowledgement invalid;
7. Any material changes to the proposed installation as specified in the original request and supporting materials filed with the Council shall require an explicit request for modification to the Council, including all relevant information regarding the proposed change with a rigorous cumulative far-field analysis for all entities located on the tower, consistent with Federal Communications Commission, Office of Engineering and Technology, Bulletin 65;
8. The Council shall be notified in writing at least two weeks prior to the commencement of site construction activities;
9. Within 45 days after completion of construction, the Council shall be notified in writing that construction has been completed along with a representative photograph of the facility modification;

10. Any nonfunctioning antenna and associated antenna mounting equipment, or other equipment at this facility owned and operated by T-Mobile shall be removed within 60 days of the date the antenna or equipment ceased to function;
11. The validity of this action shall expire one year from the date of this letter; and
12. T-Mobile may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one year deadline provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 60 days prior to the expiration.

The attached PE Closeout Letter dated March 31, 2026 provides evidence of compliance with the conditions outlined by the Council. Please find attached photos of the completed modifications to this facility.

To the best of my information, knowledge and belief, the Special Inspections required by Chapter 17 for the project have been performed and all discovered discrepancies have been reported and resolved.

Representatives of TEP OPCO, LLC performed the Final Inspections after the construction of the telecommunications facility at the above-referenced address. The Final Inspection was performed on March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

Based on my knowledge, information and belief the wireless installation substantially conforms to the approved plans, IBC 2021 with 2022 CT State Building Code Amendments, Structural Standards for Antenna Supporting Structures and Antennas (ANSI/TIA-222-H), and the following:

1. Final Construction Drawings dated 07/25/2025, prepared by Power of Design.
2. Final Structural Analysis dated 06/11/2025, prepared by B+T Group.

All deviations from the approved plans do not endanger the intended occupancy of the facility and equipment substitutions are approved as equivalent to the original specifications. This report does not include inspections for the findings of the global stability analysis and modifications to the structure. Those modification inspections, if required, are strictly the responsibility of the tower owner & general contractor performing such design and installation.

Interim reports submitted prior to this final report form a basis for and are to be considered an integral part of this final report.

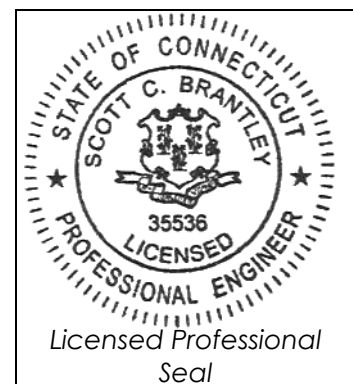
