

Mr. Wright – thank you for reaching out with this very valid concern. I quickly reviewed the project documents this afternoon and noticed a discrepancy between Crown Castle's structural analysis and the AT&T project drawings in this respect. Crown Castle, who own the tower, show the Town's antenna and the platform mount remaining (see below), whereas the Construction Drawings indicate that the mount will be removed. I'm sure that the Crown version of events is the correct one as they would not permit AT&T to remove a mount with someone else's antenna equipment on it but I will get to the bottom of this right away and advise the group.

Here is the relevant excerpt from the Page 4 of the Crown Castle structural analysis. Only equipment noted with a "3" is to be removed, whereas the whip antenna (DB636-C) and platform mount (LP 1201-1) are both marked as "1" (existing).

I have very significant concern regarding this proposed modification as it proposes removing the mount at 73' on this facility, upon which the Town of Durham has an existing antenna that is used for public safety purposes.

The Town, in fact, made significant modifications to their network to accommodate the installation of the AT&T equipment when the equipment was originally installed.

Please advise suggestions as to how to accommodate our public safety requirements while achieving your objectives. We must maintain at least 20' separation between the antenna mounted at 120'.
