RE: **EM-AT&T-044-220817** - AT&T notice of intent to modify an existing telecommunications facility located at 259 Commerce Street, East Haven, Connecticut.

Dear Domenica Tatasciore:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) hereby denies your request to modify the above-referenced existing telecommunications facility pursuant to Section 16-50j-73 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

On October 21, 2022, the Council issued a second incomplete notice for the above referenced exempt modification due to the Radio Frequency Analysis dated September 29, 2022 not accounting for T-Mobile or Metro by T-Mobile's existing installations on the tower. In response, on October 26, 2022, AT&T provided a Radio Frequency Analysis prepared by MobileComm Professionals, Inc. dated September 2, 2022, that indicates a cumulative general population percent Maximum Permissible Exposure (%MPE) of 170.98%. This exceeds the Federal Communications Commission's (FCC) allowable General Public/Uncontrolled cumulative MPE limit of 100%.

Thus, the proposed modification is not in compliance with the exemption criteria in Section 16-50j-72 (b) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.
