Re: Emergency Disaster Recovery Deployment - New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC - Temporary Cellular Communications Site on Town-Owned Property at 161 Cosey Beach Avenue, East Haven, CT

Dear Chairman Stein and Members of the Council:

New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T") has deployed a temporary cellular communications facility ("COW") to a Town-owned park at 161 Cosey Beach Avenue in East Haven to assist in Hurricane Irene disaster recovery efforts. Please accept this letter as notification to the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council"), pursuant to R.C.S.A Section 16-50j-73, of a deployment that constitutes an exempt modification under R.C.S.A Section 16-50j-72(d). In compliance with R.C.S.A. Section 16-50j-73, a copy of this letter is being sent to the Mayor of East Haven.

The temporary cell site meets the criteria set forth in R.C.S.A Section 16-50j-72(d) for emergency telephone service during a local and statewide disaster.

The Temporary Facility

AT&T operates under licenses issued by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") to provide cellular and PCS mobile telephone service in New Haven County, which includes the area to be served by AT&T's temporary installation.

The temporary cell site is located on the grounds of a Town-owned park at 161 Cosey Beach Avenue in East Haven. (See the attached location map.) A letter giving the Town's approval is also attached to this notice.

The site began operations at 1:00 pm on Thursday, September 1, 2011. Due to continuing fluidity

of the disaster recovery, we cannot state precisely how long this COW will be deployed to the site. However, AT&T anticipates the COW will be needed at that location for between one and four weeks.

AT&T's temporary cell site consists of radio equipment installed in a vehicle referred to as a "Cell on Wheels" ("COW"). The COW is 40 feet in length and 8 feet wide. A mast has been extended upward from the COW to a height of approximately 60 feet above ground level ("AGL") to support the AT&T antennas. The COW is self-contained insofar as it operates on its own electric generator and uses satellite communications rather than local utility connections.

Power Density Calculations.

AT&T's temporary cell site will not result in a total radio frequency electromagnetic radiation power density, measured at ground level in this location, at or above State or Federal standards. The following table shows the power density at the site from the temporary cellular transmissions from the COW.

Please note that the standard power density equation provided by the Council in its memo of January 22, 2001 incorporates a ground reflection factor of 2.56 as described in FCC OET Bulletin No. 65.

This "worst-case" power density calculation shows that AT&T's temporary transmissions from the COW result in a power density corresponding to approximately 47 % of the ANSI/IEEE standard for uncontrolled environments. Therefore, total worst-case density levels from temporary cellular operations at this location are within the applicable standard limits.

Conclusion

For the reasons above and pursuant to R.C.S.A. Section 16-50j-72(d), we respectfully request that the Council acknowledge this Notice of AT&T's temporary cell site used in Hurricane Irene disaster recovery efforts in East Haven.

Moreover, deployment of AT&T's hurricane disaster response has been driven in part by direction from Governor Malloy's office and local officials as to where emergency communications resources are most needed. Given the emergency nature of these events, we therefore respectfully request waiver of the normal filing fee for this Notice pursuant to the Council's authority under R.C.S.A. Sections 16-50j-3 and 16-50j-4.
