

The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy ("Eversource") received acknowledgement from the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on July 30, 2018 that Eversource's proposed modification of the Scitico Substation would comply with the exempt modification criteria in Section 16-50j-57 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.
