We are in receipt of your letter dated June 9, 2016 concerning the above-referenced matter. Please be advised that we are in the process of meeting the requirement to produce a passing structural analysis on this site, not exceeding 100 percent.

The subject tower was recently modified by T-Mobile and AT&T's modifications were considered in the modification design. T-Mobile's modifications were completed and American Tower is in the process of conducting a post modification inspection and will run a structural thereafter demonstrating that AT&T's equipment is compliant with your tower loading requirement.

In light of the above, we will be unable to produce the structural requested in the timeframe provided, but are working to bring the site into compliance as soon as possible. As such, a structural will be filed as soon as it becomes available.
