As you know, at their meeting of July 29, 1999, the Siting Council acknowledged receipt of notice of the above-referenced exempt modification proposed for the existing telecommunications tower at 281 Woodhouse Road in Fairfield, Connecticut.

In my July 6, 1999 notice letter to you, I referred to three (3) whip-type antennas which would be installed on the tower by Pagenet. In fact, Pagenet would like to install five (5) whip-type antennas at the 118' level on the Fairfield tower. The tower profile drawing submitted with my July 6, 1999 letter correctly depicts five (5) Pagenet antennas.

The addition of two (2) additional whip-type antennas at the 118' level does not affect the Siting Council's decision that this proposed modification satisfies the regulatory criteria in R.C.S.A. § 16-50j-72(b)(2). Further, the addition of two (2) whip-type antennas by Pagenet will not increase the overall power density emissions at the site boundary.

I would submit that this minor modification could be approved administratively without a need to return for a vote of the full Council. However, if you believe otherwise, we would respectfully request that this matter be placed on the Council's August 16, 1999 agenda.
