Dear Attorney Bachman:

The Connecticut Light and Power Company dba Eversource Energy ("Eversource") received acknowledgement from the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on April 18, 2022 to its Notice that Eversource's proposed modifications at the existing Farmington Substation at 29 Old Mountain would comply with the exception criteria outlined in Section 16-50j-57(a) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. In its acknowledgement, the Council included conditions regarding the proposed work, including the following;

- The Requestor may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one-year deadline, provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 45 days prior to the expiration.

Due to supply chain issues and material delivery, the Project requires additional time to complete. Eversource hereby requests that the one-year deadline to complete the Project be extended to April, 18, 2024.
