RE: **EM-VER-057-220616** – Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless notice of intent to modify an existing telecommunications facility located at 36 Ritch Avenue, Greenwich, Connecticut.

Dear Ms. Bateman:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) hereby denies your request to modify the above-referenced existing telecommunications facility, pursuant to Section 16-50j-73 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

This exempt modification request was submitted to the Council on June 16, 2022. Council staff reviewed this request for completeness and had identified deficiencies that were more fully described in notice of incompletion letters to the requesting entity dated July 18, 2022 and August 4, 2022 and recommended that Verizon provide a revised and updated cumulative Radio Frequency Analysis Report including a rigorous far-field analysis for Verizon that accounts for a 6-foot tall person and the actual antenna pattern for the proposed modifications with a cumulative % Maximum Permissible Exposure at or below 100% on or before September 2, 2022. To date the Council has not received the requested information.

Thus, the proposed modification is not in compliance with the exemption criteria in Section 16-50j-72 (b) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies and is hereby denied.
