
The Connecticut Light and Power Company (“CL&P”) doing business as Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) received acknowledgement from the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) on August 18, 2019 that Eversource’s proposed modification of the Stepstone Substation would comply with the exempt modification criteria in Section 16-50j-57 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. The Council included conditions regarding the work undertaken pursuant to modification. On May 30, 2019, the Council granted an extension of time to submit the notice of completion by June 28, 2020. Eversource submits this letter to provide notice that Eversource has complied with the Council’s conditions as follows:

- Written notification to the Council not less than 45 days after construction has been completed. Eversource completed construction on April 3, 2020; this letter provides notice of completion of this modification.
- There were no material changes or other deviations to this modification.

Per the Council’s instructions in response to COVID-19, Eversource is submitting this Notice of Completion electronically and will be providing one hard copy for the Council’s records.
