RE: **EM-CLEARWIRE-064-100602** – Clearwire Corporation notice of intent to modify an existing telecommunications facility located at 219 New Park Avenue, Hartford, Connecticut.

Dear Mr. Flynn:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) hereby acknowledges your notice to modify this existing telecommunications facility, pursuant to Section 16-50j-73 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies with the following conditions:

- a) the antennas and/or microwave dishes to be installed on this tower be installed in such a way that their highest points do not exceed 102 feet above ground level;
- b) not more than 45 days after completion of construction, a signed letter from a Professional Engineer duly licensed in the State of Connecticut shall be submitted to the Council to certify that the antennas and/or microwave dishes have been installed in compliance with condition a.

The proposed modifications are to be implemented as specified here and in your notice dated June 2, 2010, including the placement of all necessary equipment and shelters within the tower compound. The modifications are in compliance with the exception criteria in Section 16-50j-72 (b) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies as changes to an existing facility site that would not increase tower height, extend the boundaries of the tower site, increase noise levels at the tower site boundary by six decibels, and increase the total radio frequencies electromagnetic radiation power density measured at the tower site boundary to or above the standard adopted by the State Department of Environmental Protection pursuant to General Statutes § 22a-162. This facility has also been carefully modeled to ensure that radio frequency emissions are conservatively below State and federal standards applicable to the frequencies now used on this tower.

This decision is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Council. Please be advised that the validity of this action shall expire one year from the date of this letter. Any additional change to this facility will require explicit notice to this agency pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-73. Such notice shall include all relevant information regarding the proposed change with cumulative worst-case
