Dear Mr. Shepherd:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) received notices of intent to modify the above-referenced facilities between August 20, 2021 and August 26, 2021.

According to Section 16-50j-71 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, "...any modification, as defined in Section 16-50j-2a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, to an existing tower site, except as specified in Sections 16-50j-72 and 16-50j-88 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, may have a substantial adverse environmental effect."

Staff has reviewed these exempt modification requests for completeness and has identified deficiencies in the submittals. These exempt modification requests lack documentation of the original facility approval and any conditions of such approval or correspondence with each host municipality stating that the town no longer retains records of its decision and property card/map identifying the underlying property owner.

Therefore, these exempt modification requests are incomplete at this time. The Council recommends that SBA provide documentation showing the original facility approval with conditions, if any, or

correspondence with the host municipality stating that there are no records of the original facility approval and property card/map identifying the underlying property owner, on or before October 29, 2021. If additional time is needed to gather the requested information, please submit a written request for an extension of time prior to October 29, 2021. **Please provide an electronic version and one hard copy of the requested information for each incomplete exempt modification to be rendered complete and processed. Please include the Council's exempt modification identification number referenced above with the submittal.**

This notice of incompleteness shall have the effect of tolling the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) 60-day timeframe in accordance with Paragraph 217 of the FCC Wireless Infrastructure Report and Order issued on October 21, 2014 (FCC 14-153).
