Dear Ms. Sabo:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) hereby denies your request to modify the above-referenced existing telecommunications facility, pursuant to Section 16-50j-73 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

This exempt modification request was submitted to the Council on August 16, 2021. Council staff reviewed this request for completeness and had identified some deficiencies that were more fully described in a notice of incompletion to the requesting entity dated September 22, 2021 and recommended that Northeast Site Solutions provide the revised construction drawings that does not have conflicting information, and applicable antenna Mount Analysis and Structural Analysis that accounts for the proposed modifications, on or before October 22, 2021. To date the Council has not received the requested information.

Thus, the proposed modification is not in compliance with the exemption criteria in Section 16-50j-72 (b) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies and is hereby denied.
