The following are the basis for substantiating compliance with the tower modification documents prepared by On-Air Engineering, LLC:

- Review of FDH Velocitel's Structural Analysis (FDH project #15CAXZ1400 R.1) dated 10/21/15;
- Review of On-Air Engineering, LLC's AWS Site Modification drawing dated 5/6/2016; and
- Photographs of the completed modifications which determined all modifications were installed in general compliance with the recommendations of the aforementioned structural analysis.
