Dear Mr. Russo:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) received the tower share request for the above-referenced facility on July 12, 2019.

According to Section 16-50j-90 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, "no tower share application shall be approved until a complete application containing all information deemed relevant by the Council has been filed. Relevant information shall at a minimum include that listed in Section 16-50j-89 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies..."

Staff has reviewed this tower share request for completeness and has identified the following deficiencies:

- 1. The Structural Modification Report (SA) prepared by American Tower Corporation and dated January 2, 2019 is missing the cover page which contains the site address and %stress capacity, the page showing the table of contents and the page containing the introduction and conclusion.
- 2. The SA references the 2016 Connecticut State Building Code (CSBC). The 2018 CSBC became effective on October 1, 2018.
- 3. The submittal lacks proof that the tower share request was physically mailed to the chief elected official of the Town of Killingly.

Therefore, the tower share request is incomplete at this time. The Council recommends that T-Squared Site Services provide a complete SA that references the 2018 CSBC and proof of notice to the town CEO, on or before August 7, 2019. If additional time is needed to gather the requested information, please submit a written request for an extension of time prior to August 7, 2019. Please provide an electronic version and one hard copy of the response for the incomplete request to be rendered complete and the tower share processed.

This notice of incompletion shall have the effect of tolling the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) 60-day timeframe in accordance with Paragraph 217 of the FCC Wireless Infrastructure Report and Order issued on October 21, 2014 (FCC 14-153).
