RE: **TS-VER-077-180405** – Celco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless request to amend an order for tower sharing at an existing telecommunications facility located at 33 Mitchell Drive, Manchester, Connecticut. **Request to Revise.**

Dear Attorney Baldwin:

At a public meeting of the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) held on November 8, 2018, the Council approved the requested amendment dated October 22, 2018, to the above-referenced tower share request that was originally approved by the Council on May 11, 2018 with the following condition:

1. Approval of any minor changes be delegated to Council staff.

This decision is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Council. This facility has been carefully modeled to ensure that radio frequency emissions are conservatively below State and federal standards applicable to the frequencies now used on this tower. Any deviation from this format may result in the Council implementing enforcement proceedings pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50u including, without limitation, imposition of expenses resulting from such failure and of civil penalties in an amount not less than one thousand dollars per day for each day of construction or operation in material violation.

This decision applies only to the requested tower share amendment and is not applicable to any other request or construction. Please be advised that the validity of this action shall expire one year from the date of this letter.

The proposed shared use is to be implemented as specified in your tower share request letter dated April 3, 2018 and request for an amendment letter dated October 22, 2018, including the placement of all necessary equipment and shelters within the tower compound.
