Dear Attorney Donaldson:

At a public meeting held on August 29, 2001, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) acknowledged your notice to modify this existing telecommunications facility, pursuant to Section 16-50j-73 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

The proposed modifications are to be implemented as specified here and in your notice dated August 14, 2001. The modifications are in compliance with the exception criteria in Section 16-50j-72 (b) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies as changes to an existing facility site that would not increase tower height, extend the boundaries of the tower site, increase noise levels at the tower site boundary by six decibels, and increase the total radio frequencies electromagnetic radiation power density measured at the tower site boundary to or above the standard adopted by the State Department of Environmental Protection pursuant to General Statutes § 22a-162.

This decision is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the Council. Any additional change to this facility will require explicit notice to this agency pursuant to Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies Section 16-50j-73. Such notice shall include all relevant information regarding the proposed change with cumulative worst-case modeling of radio frequency exposure at the closest point of uncontrolled access to the tower base, consistent with Federal Communications Commission, Office of Engineering and Technology, Bulletin 65. Any deviation from this format may result in the Council implementing enforcement proceedings pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50u including, without limitation, imposition of expenses resulting from such failure and of civil penalties in an amount not less than one thousand dollars per day for each day of construction or operation in material violation.

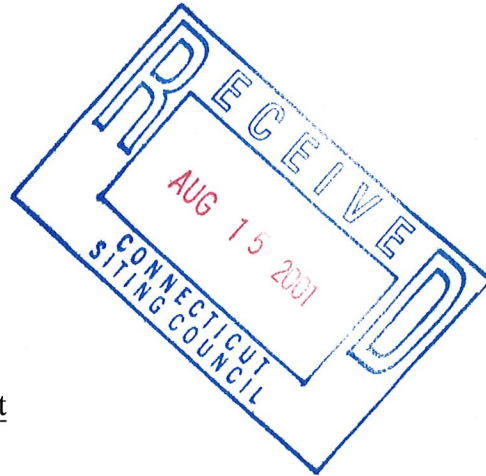

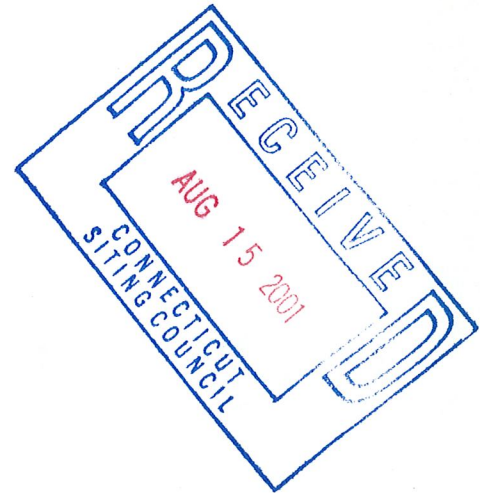

Dear Mr. Rinebold:

Sprint Spectrum LP ("Sprint PCS") hereby requests acknowledgement that Sprint PCS's proposed modification of the telecommunications facility on a tower owned by Sprint Sites USA located on property owned by the University of Connecticut ("UCONN") at 82 North Eagleville Road, Storrs, Connecticut (the "Facility") constitutes an exempt modification pursuant to R.C.S.A. § 16-50j-72(b)(2). The Facility was constructed by Sprint PCS to provide reliable PCS service at low cost to the students and staff at UCONN, to provide UCONN with free PCS equipment, and to provide PCS service to the area in and around UCONN in accordance with Sprint PCS's FCC license.

Under this request for acknowledgment, Sprint PCS proposes to remove its existing minicell and power cabinet at the Facility and install modcell cabinets, power and battery backup to the existing frame. Sprint PCS also proposes to remove the existing 100 amp Sprint PCS PPC-mini cabinet and replace it with a 200 amp PPC-mini cabinet, as well the other minor site modifications shown on the Site Plan attached hereto. Please accept this letter as notification, pursuant to R.C.S.A. § 16-50j-73, of modification to an existing telecommunications facility, which constitutes an exempt modification pursuant to R.C.S.A. § 16-50j-72(b)(2). In accordance with R.C.S.A. § 16-50j-73, a copy of this letter is being sent to Martin Berliner, the Town Manager of Mansfield, Connecticut.


The Facility consists of a 250-foot tower and related equipment located at 82 North Eagleville Road, Storrs, Connecticut. This Facility is currently being used for personal wireless communications services by Sprint PCS, Nextel Communications, Inc., Verizon Wireless, and Omnipoint Communications. The Facility also contains equipment owned and operated by UCONN.

Sprint PCS plans to upgrade its existing equipment at the Facility without making any changes to the equipment frame, the existing antennas or the tower. The proposed modifications to the Facility fall squarely within and satisfy the requirements set forth in R.C.S.A. § 16-50j-72(b)(2):

1. The proposed modifications will not increase the height of the tower.
2. The removal and replacement of Sprint PCS's equipment on its existing frame will not require an extension of the site boundaries or alter the access and utility routing at the Facility as shown in the Site Plan attached hereto.
3. The proposed modifications will not increase the noise levels at the Facility by six decibels or more.
4. The proposed modification will not require the alteration or addition of antennas and therefore, will not increase the total radio frequency (RF) power density at the Facility to a level at or above the applicable standard.

For the foregoing reasons, Sprint PCS respectfully submits that the proposed modification of Sprint PCS's equipment at the Facility constitutes an exempt modification pursuant to R.C.S.A. § 16-50j-72(b)(2).
