On June 16, 2022, The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy ("Eversource") provided notice to the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) of its intent, in accordance with Section 16-50j-57(a) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, to replace a failed 46.7 megavolt ampere ("MVA") transformer at its existing 115-kilovolt ('kV") / 13.8-kV East Meriden Substation ("Substation") with a new 62.5 MVA transformer. The transformer was replaced within the fenced Substation area, which encompasses approximately 0.7 acre within Eversource's 8.8-acre property at 300 High Hill Road in the City of Meriden, New Haven County, Connecticut.
