RE: **EM-VER-080-210917** – Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless notice of intent to modify an existing telecommunications facility located at 450-478 West Main Street, Meriden, Connecticut.

Dear Ms. Sabo:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) hereby denies your request to modify the above-referenced existing telecommunications facility, pursuant to Section 16-50j-73 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

This exempt modification request was submitted to the Council on September 17, 2021. Council staff reviewed this request for completeness and identified a deficiency that was more fully described in a notice of incompleteness letter to the requesting entity dated October 20, 2021 recommending that Northeast Site Solutions provide a cumulative power density analysis including Verizon's proposed antennas in addition to all existing antennas of other wireless carriers documenting a Maximum Permissible Exposure at or below 100 percent, on or before November 22, 2021. To date the Council has not received the requested information.

Thus, the proposed modification is not in compliance with the exemption criteria in Section 16-50j-72 (b) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies and is hereby denied.
