Request Pursuant to Condition No. 3 - Commencement of Construction

Dear Attorney Bachman:

The Connecticut Siting Council's ("Council") ruling of the above-referenced Project, dated November 3, 2025, conditions Eversource to provide two weeks of advance notice prior to the start of construction. Eversource is requesting a modification to Condition No. 3 that allows the Project to provide a one-week advance notification to the Council. This would allow the Project to begin civil construction - mowing and the installation of matting - on November 13th. Beginning the civil construction as soon as possible is necessary to meet the line outage scheduled to begin on December 8th.
