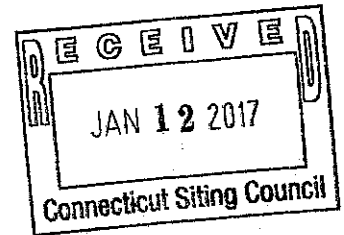

Dear Ms. Bachman:

The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy (Eversource) received acknowledgement from the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) on May 18, 2015 and that Eversource's proposed modification of the East New Britain Substation would comply with the exempt modification criteria in Section 16-50j-57 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies

The Council included conditions regarding this exempt modification work. Eversource is requesting an extension of the deadline for completing the construction based on the following condition:

The petitioner may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one year deadline, provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 60 days prior to the expiration.

As stated in the request for extension approved on March 15, 2016, the construction was scheduled to be completed by November of 2016. Due to other priority work and changes in the outage schedule, the electrical portion of the Project is delayed until November of 2017; however, the fence modification, gates and foundation work are completed. Eversource hereby requests that the one year deadline to complete these activities be extended to December 31, 2017.
