Dear Attorney Bachman:

The Connecticut Light and Power Company dba Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) received acknowledgement from the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) on March 6, 2023, of its Notice that Eversource’s proposed modifications at the existing Shunock Substation at 25 Pendleton Road in North Stonington would comply with the exception criteria outlined in Section 16-50j-57(a) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. In its acknowledgement, the Council included conditions regarding the proposed work, including the following;

- Eversource may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one-year deadline, provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 60 days prior to the expiration.

Due to project delays, Eversource requires additional time to complete the Project. Eversource hereby requests that the one-year deadline to complete the Project be extended to March 6, 2025.
