Notification of Temporary Construction Area

Dear Attorney Bachman:

On July 24, 2023, the Connecticut Siting Council acknowledged the subject Exempt Modification submitted by The Connecticut Light and Power Company d/b/a Eversource Energy to modify an existing energy facility located at 49 Bokum Road, Old Saybrook, Connecticut.

The proposed work at Bokum Substation ("Substation") now requires a temporary construction area, of approximately 4,025 square feet for the installation of an underground distribution line in an area that is outside the eastern fence of the Substation (see Attachment A). This installation will require the temporary relocation of the Substation fence in that area, the clearing of ground vegetation and the removal of five trees. The temporary fence will be installed along the outside of this construction area during this work and the permanent Substation fence will be reinstalled in its original location once the work is completed. No grading of this area is required. The visibility of the Substation to the abutting property owners or from Bokum Road will not be impacted due to the location of the limited vegetation removal.

Eversource representatives have briefed officials in the Town of Old Saybrook regarding this temporary construction area and the Town does not have any objection.
