

Dear Attorney Baldwin:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) received a notice of intent to modify the above-referenced facility on April 18, 2019.

According to Section 16-50j-71 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, "...any modification, as defined in Section 16-50j-2a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, to an existing tower site, except as specified in Sections 16-50j-72 and 16-50j-88 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, may have a substantial adverse environmental effect."

Staff has reviewed this exempt modification request for completeness and has identified a deficiency in the Structural Analysis Report (SA) provided with the filing. The SA provided is dated February 6, 2019. The Council had received a request for exempt modification from T-Mobile for the same facility in October of 2018. The above-referenced request for exempt modification does not include T-Mobile's approved equipment. Please see T-Mobile's exempt modification filing for this facility, which may be found on the Council's website under the Decisions page in Orange under the filing number EM-T-Mobile-107-181025 or by following the link:

Therefore, the exempt modification request is incomplete at this time. The Council recommends that Robinson & Cole, LLP, provide an updated SA for the facility that includes proposed and approved equipment by T-Mobile and other entities that are located at this facility on or before May 24, 2019. If additional time is needed to gather the requested information, please submit a written request for an extension of time prior to May 24, 2019. Please provide an electronic version and one hard copy of the updated SA for the incomplete request to be rendered complete and processed.

This notice of incompletion shall have the effect of tolling the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) 60-day timeframe in accordance with Paragraph 217 of the FCC Wireless Infrastructure Report and Order issued on October 21, 2014 (FCC 14-153).
