On May 18, 2015, the Siting Council acknowledged receipt of Cellco's notice of intent to modify its telecommunications facility at 47-51 Unity Street in Plainfield, Connecticut. The modifications involved the replacement of its existing antennas, the installation of remote radio heads and the installation of a new fiber optic antenna cable.

We are providing this "Tower Modification Certification" with regard to the structural components at the above referenced project.

The following are the basis for substantiating compliance with the tower modification documents prepared by Black & Veach (Black & Veach Project Number: 182896):

- Review of Black & Veach Structural Modification Report dated 11/25/2014.
- Field observations by Centek Engineering personnel on 12/16/2015 of the completed modifications which determined all modifications were installed in general compliance with the recommendations of the report prepared by Black & Veach on 11/25/2014.

The modification design prepared by Black & Veach demonstrates the tower will not exceed 100 percent of the post construction structural rating. The work under this Contract has been reviewed and found, to the Engineer's best knowledge, information and belief, to be completed in general compliance with the documents referenced above. This certification is not a review of the adequacy or effectiveness of the modification/reinforcement solution.
