Dear Ms. Bachman:

The Connecticut Light and Power Company doing business as Eversource Energy ("Eversource") received acknowledgement from the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on December 24, 2018, that Eversource's proposed modification of Structure 991 would comply with the exempt modification criteria in Section 16-50j-57 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies. The Council included conditions regarding the modification work, including, specifically the following:

• The petitioner may file a request for an extension of time beyond the one-year deadline, provided that such request is submitted to the Council not less than 60 days prior to the expiration.

Due to the project construction schedule being delayed, Eversource hereby requests that the one-year deadline to complete these activities be extended to December 24, 2020.
