Dear Attorney Bachman:

On November 6, 2023, Eversource Energy (“Eversource”) received an acknowledgement from the Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) of Eversource’s notice of intent to modify an existing energy facility, the Mystic Substation, located at 148 Greenmanville Avenue, Stonington, Connecticut. Among other conditions of the acknowledgement, the Council required that Eversource submit the following item:

- Not less than 45 days after completion of construction, the Council shall be notified in writing that construction has been completed.

Construction was completed on March 19, 2024. Additionally, representative photographs of the completed modification to the existing energy facility, are included as *Attachment A*.

Eversource will be providing one original and two hard copies of this notice in the mail for the Council’s records.
