RE: **EM-T-MOBILE-141-210722 -** T-Mobile notice of intent to modify an existing telecommunications facility located at 720 Quinebaug Road, Thompson, Connecticut.

Dear Mr. Breun:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) hereby denies your request to modify the above-referenced existing telecommunications facility, pursuant to Section 16-50j-73 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA).

According to Section 16-50j-71 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, "...any modification, as defined in Section 16-50j-2a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, to an existing tower site, except as specified in Sections 16-50j-72 and 16-50j-88 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, may have a substantial adverse environmental effect."

Staff has reviewed this request for completeness and has identified a deficiency in compliance with the criteria set forth in RCSA Section 16-50j-72. The exempt modification request dated July 9, 2021 states in the last sentence of the first paragraph of the cover letter that, "T-Mobile now intends to add a 25Kw generator to a proposed 10'x4' concrete pad within the existing compound" However, Construction Drawing (CD) C-1 indicates an expanded lease area approximately eight feet west outside the existing fenced facility. Also, CD C-1 proposes no fencing around the proposed generator.

It is evident that T-Mobile is requesting to extend the lease area of the site. This request to extend the lease area of an existing site is not consistent with the criteria set forth in RCSA Section16-50j-72. Such a request is properly submitted to the Council in the form of a petition for a declaratory ruling.

Therefore, this request does not qualify as an exempt modification request and it is hereby rejected on that basis. The Council recommends that T-Mobile submit a petition for declaratory ruling.
