Dear Ms. Davis:

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) hereby denies your request to modify the above-referenced existing telecommunications facility, pursuant to Section 16-50j-73 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

This exempt modification request was submitted to the Council on November 22, 2021. Council staff reviewed this request for completeness and identified a deficiency that was more fully described in a notice of incompletion letter to the requesting entity dated December 21, 2021 recommending that Crown Castle provide a Radio Frequency Analysis Report for the proposed modifications to the facility with a cumulative General Public/Uncontrolled MPE at or below 100%, on or before January 20, 2022. To date the Council has not received the requested information.

Thus, the proposed modification is not in compliance with the exemption criteria in Section 16-50j-72 (b) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies and is hereby denied. Sincerely,
